NARD Report: Gene Kelly reported that their next meeting would be in conjunction with the NARD Annual Conference in Kearney. DNR Report: No Report.

NRCS Report: Brandon Peterson's report was mailed out to the Directors. Aaron Romesser, Resource Conservationist from the O'Neill office attended the meeting. Aaron reported that they are wrapping up EQIP contracts; CRP is currently on hold; and, they are waiting on the state office to obligate funds for the CSP applications. They have also completed approximately 95% of their compliance reviews.

RC&D Report:

North Central RC&D: Marv Fritz gave an brief overview of the items which the RC&D has been working on and introduced Kim Burge to give further details on the Tire Amnesty event they would like the UENRD to sponsor a grant for. Kim explained how the tire amnesty event would be held and what organizations would be involved. The North Central RC&D needs a public entity to sponsor the grant for the tire amnesty event. The UENRD would have to pay the initial costs and then be reimbursed through the grant process. The whole process should take 30-60 days and would be an in/out for the budget. ⇒It was moved by Keith Heithoff and seconded by Marv Fritz to apply for the NDEE grant for the Tire Amnesty Event to be held in Ewing, NE in the amount of \$126,000 for the FY 23-24 budget. Reminder letters for water sampling have gone out to those cooperators who need samples for this year and those who will need them next year for Nitrogen Management certification. Joslynn also reported that the Bazile Groundwater Management Area is planning a farmer appreciation night August 24.

Bazile Management Report: Lisa Lauver-BGMA Coordinator's and Jeremy Milander-BGMA Assistant Extension Educator reports were mailed out in the Directors packets. Dennis Schueth reported that Jeremy Milander will be resigning from his position at the end of July for a new opportunity with NECC. Since the grant which funded Jeremy's position will be expiring, UNL is re-evaluating the position.

UNL Extension: Dennis Schueth reported that UNL conducted interviews for the Forester position which has been housed in O'Neill. There were a couple of candidates selected; however, they both ended up declining the position. UNL is currently in a hiring freeze but since this position was advertised before the hiring freeze they will hopefully be able to fill it.

Since the Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality no longer exists and has become the Nebraska Department of Environment and Energy, the UENRD needs to update its Chemigation Rules and Regulations to be in compliance with the states changes. The vote to go to public hearing will need to be done in September or October. The Committee is also discussing the Chemigation application fees and whether or not they should be changed.
