Donita Pokorny, Dana F Cole, attended the board meeting. Donita reviewed the audit report explaining the different aspects of the audit and answering questions from the board. AGENCY & STAFF REPORTS:

NARD Report: Gene Kelly reported that the paydown on the new NARD building was from the NARD Foundation not the Risk Pool funds. Over \$26,000 was raised for the Foundation at the annual conference in September with a total of \$136,000 being raised for the Foundation this year. Gene also listed the organizations sponsored by the Foundation and the contributions for the upcoming year. NARD has been requested to sponsor 3 Climate Smart events. It was noted that Farm Bureau is supporting the current funding status of the NRDs and not the EPIC tax funding. The NARD Board has given Dean Edson, Executive Director, the latitude to join a group of concerned organizations regarding the EPIC Tax movement and if needed be part of any formal group activity. There are a lot of questions surrounding the proposed EPIC Tax to be answered before any action is to be taken. Gene reviewed the award nomination deadlines for the Leopold Award and NARD awards. NARD has also hired a new intern who will be helping out at the office.

- The NARD Legislative Conference is scheduled for January 23 & 24, 2024 at the Embassy Suites in Lincoln. The UENRD will need to appoint voting delegates for this conference. ⇒It was moved by Chris Dierks and seconded by Curtis Gotschall to appoint Gene Kelly Delegate and Kevin Blair Alternate as voting delegates for the NARD Legislative Conference. - **GMDA Conference:** The Groundwater Management Districts Association conference will be held January 23-25, 2024 in Nashville, TN. This is the same time as the NARD Legislative Conference.

NeDNR Report: No Report.

NRCS Report: Brandon Peterson's report was mailed out to the Directors. Brandon reported that they have received 203 EQIP applications and 6 CSP applications between the two offices. They are still waiting on the national office to approve the cost list for EQIP with CSP being processed for IRA. Also, due to a lack of guidance from the national office they are no longer able to have EQIP and Grassland CRP on the same acres. Holt County has also been selected to host the Area 5 range judging in 2024. NRCS continues to operate on a continuing resolution which is set to expire January 18, 2024.

• MOA between NRDs and NRCS: A copy of the Memorandum of Understanding between the NRD and NRCS was distributed to the board for their review. The MOA is reviewed annually and requires partners to comply with their responsibilities. ⇒It was moved by Matt Beckman and seconded by Tony Sanderson to approve the Memorandum of Agreement between the NRCS and UENRD. Source Water Protection Position-Wellhead Protection Area: NRCS would like to partner with the NRDs and hire Source Water Protection positions to promote conservation measures within and outside wellhead protection areas. They are looking for a 50/50 match from the NRDs. Dennis Schueth reported that he is hoping for more information on this position, coverage area and how the funding would need to occur.

RC&D Reports:

North Central RC&D: Marv Fritz reported that the RC&D has received the Tire Amnesty grant. The event will be held in the Newport area in April. The RC&D will be advertising for Kim's position in January. Marv also reported that he attended a Pivot Bio meeting with Dennis Schueth and he noted that the technology they are developing is very interesting.

Joslynn reported that the deadline for Phase II reports is December 31, 2023 and the office has received approximately 800 out of the 2600 forms needed to be filed with the UENRD. Reminder letters were sent out in November. Phase III soil sampling is almost completed with only one field left to sample which should be done this week. Joslynn reviewed the Producer Connect flyer that was included in the Director's packets and handed out the 2023 Nitrate Water Sampling Summary for the Director's to review. She will go over the results at next months meeting.
